- Multiple members of the Faith community met on July 30 to connect to better understand what services are available for people experiencing homelessness, and how better the Faith Community can help end homelessness. Ms. Blaylock pointed out that Faith money is not restricted by government funds so they can fill in the gaps of service, so they want to be good partners for the service providers.

III. Continuum Business

- NOFA
 - a. DV bonus
 1. One Roof is strongly encouraging applications for the DV Bonus and will help agencies explore that opportunity. It is possible to do housing or an SSO to do Coordinated Assessment specifically for DV clients. Housing could be PSH, RRH, or RRH/TH Hybrid
 2. The DV bonus is \$658,795 this year, but could be a smaller amount as long as it is a minimum of \$50,000.
 3. Rapid Rehousing grant- generally 18 months of tiered assistance plus an additional 6 months of potential support.

4. The Hybrid-Rapid Rehousing and Transitional. This is NOT an opportunity to do a straight Transitional project. At any time, if a program participant who wishes to do so, they must be able to move from TH to RRH. RRH must be legitimately offered to all participants....not presented as an off-handed minor option. Agencies must be able to prove the availability of both options at any time to the CoC when monitored and upon surprise visits and to HUD if audited.
- b. reallocation
 1. Per HUD guidelines, we should have reallocated at least 20% of total Annual Renewal Demand between FY 2015 and FY 2019 or approximately \$1.8 million.
 2. Reallocation-should be done to move money from poorly performing projects to projects that perform well or to create new projects.
 3. Reallocation can also be done with a portion of or all money left on the table from one or more grants and move it to a new or existing project.
 - c. bonus projects \$461,155 available, but we probably won't earn a bonus unless we reallocate
 1. Can be PSH
 2. Can be RRH
 3. Applicants must be One Roof members
 - d. remember your membership requirements
 1. Must attend 80% of membership meetings.
 2. Must be current with membership dues.
 3. Must participate in One Roof events. (PIT, Cardboard Connect, Project Homeless Connect)
