

Hepatitis A (Hep A) Vaccine

WHO SHOULD GET THE HEPATITIS A VACCINE?

The following groups are at a high risk to get Hepatitis A, and are encouraged to get vaccinated:

- People who use street/illegal drugs.
- People engaging in oral and/or anal sex with someone infected with Hepatitis A, including men who have sex with men.
- People who are currently homeless or in transient living.
- Incarcerated or recently incarcerated people.
- People sharing a living space with someone infected with Hepatitis A.
- International travelers.



In addition, people who have chronic liver disease or are immunocompromised may have severe complications from Hepatitis A infection and need to be vaccinated.

If you, your family, or friends engage in the activities or have the medical conditions listed above, have contact with an infected person, or contact with someone who participates in the activities listed above, please ask about Hepatitis A vaccine.

**If you fall into one of these risk groups,
please ask about being vaccinated.**
