II. Continuum Business

- Warming Station and Shelter Waiting Site Updates
 - Will be open starting Friday January 8th and remain open through Tuesday January 12th with the possibility of staying open Wednesday January 13th as well.
 - One Roof and partner agencies will continue to provide staffing to check bags entering the building and conducting intake with guests.
- 2021 Point-in-Time Count, January 25th – 29th
 - Call for Outreach leaders from partner agencies for unsheltered count
 1. Experienced street outreach staff members are needed to help conduct the unsheltered night count. Each staff member will lead a group of no more than 2-3 other staff/volunteers.
 2. Any staff member who has experience working directly with clients (in any capacity) are needed to help with the day count. Similarly, each staff member will lead a small group of 2-3 staff/volunteers.
 - All staff and volunteers will be provided with appropriate PPE, hand sanitizer, and other guidance on safety protocols.
 - Staff/volunteers will sign up for 4 hour shifts
 - One Roof will reach out to agencies regarding shelter count.
- COVID-19 Vaccine Updates
 - Shelter residents and staff are categorized under 1b on the State's Public Health schedule to receive the vaccine.
 - Alabama Regional Medical Services (ARMS), Anthony Gardner, CEO

1. ARMS has been encouraging all of their medical staff members to accept the vaccine.
2. UAB might open vaccines up to more agencies because of the low utilization rates, but this is to be determined.
3. When the vaccine becomes available to the next distribution tier, ARMS expects to distribute vaccine doses using a strategy similar to their COVID-19 testing procedure: appointments and drive-thru.
