 - o Bellamy Residential Flyer
 - Is this permanent housing? It can be either temporary or permanent depending on the resident's need.
 - Houses are typically on the west side of town.
 - o All the homes will be convenient to a bus line.
 - Each client will have a separate lease.
 - Homes are fair housing compliant.
 - Price range-dictated by the size of the room
 - How many to a house? 3-4 people typically
 - No criminal background checks
 - o Every resident will have their own bedroom with lock.
 - o The style will be similar to a college dorm. Residents can bring their own micro fridge.
 - No credit checks.
 - Lease term-6 months-1 year; 3 months leases are available.
 - What happens if conflicts don't self-resolve? First step will be for him to assist. If issue is not resolved, then he will contact referring agency.
 - What about women with children? He is not opposed to women with children but rooms cannot hold more than 2 people.
 - All household appliances included. No food is included.
 - Residents must be self-sufficient.
 - o Are the homes wheelchair accessible? Some homes are wheelchair accessible.
 - Washer and dryers are included.
 - All utilities including Wi-Fi, internet and cable.
