1934 Federal Housing Association

- Homeloans
- Insurance
- Redlining -creates systemic issues
- 1944 GI Bill
  - Low interest rate for mortgages for returning veterans
  - Excluded minorities
  - Contributed to ownership/wealth gap

1967 MLK the other America

1968 Fair Housing Act

- Defined 7 protected classes of people
- Fair Housing Alabama 30th year (1993)

    - CoC Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) = 12
    - CoC Rapid ReHousing (RRH) = 10
