Provider Description	<p>Replacing a SS Card can be done the following ways: To replace SS Card: Mail-in a SS-5 application, along with requested documents. Go to https://www.ssa.gov/forms/ to locate the form; Walk-in to the downtown Birmingham SSA Office without an appt if it is a 'matter that takes 15 mins or less'. If more than 15 mins, schedule an appt over the phone; Must provide 'evidence of identity' including - Drivers License, State ID, US Passport, or certified medical record, must include your SS Card and must be SEALED. Will only accept ORIGINAL documents - NO COPIES.</p>
