- We are waiting for the NOFA to be released. It can be expected to be released in the next 30 or so days.
 - There is a new housing type, a hybrid of Transitional Housing and Rapid Rehousing. The Continuum will encourage youth and domestic violence providers to look into this new option, as it could be most beneficial to those populations and their particular needs.
- It's important to remember that the Continuum is now being graded on the performance of not just CoC-funded agencies, but also those agencies who are not CoC-funded. System Performance Measures are designed to measure the outcomes of the entire CoC system. This is what HUD is interested in now, not just HUD funded agencies. One Roof PromisSE team will begin monitoring, addressing data issues, and retraining end users as necessary to support positive data outcomes.
